

Sehr geehrte Damen und Herren,

das Budapester Memorandum vom 5.12.1994, ist die einzige Vereinbarung bei welchem Ukraine Kasachstan und Belarus – 3. ehem. Atommächte gegen Sicherheiten ihre Atomwaffen bereits im Jahr 1996 abgetreten haben. Der 35. Jahrestag hat ohne eine Medienecho stattgefunden. Dieses Memorandum könnte eine Blaupause für weitere Staaten wie z.B. den Iran & Nord Korea usw. sein.

Die Zuschrift von einem Journalisten aus Kiew zeigt jedoch, dass Memorandum zurzeit sogar in der Ukraine kein Thema ist.

*“Regarding the **Budapest Memorandum**. Nowadays there are practically no discussions about him. A heated discussion of this document took place about two years ago in connection with the possible use of this document as an instrument of countering Russian aggression in Ukraine. These discussions ended with the collective West popularly explaining to us that we are idiots who, in fact, renounced the world's third nuclear potential (after the United States and Russia) without compensation.*

It was popularly explained to Ukraine that a memorandum is not an agreement. It does not bear any legal obligations. In addition, at that time Ukraine was sent to the fact that the Memorandum provides "security guarantees", as it appears in its French, Russian and Ukrainian texts. But the United States and Great Britain then pointed out that the English text does not speak of any "security guarantees", but only of "security assurances". And "guarantees" and "assurances" are two completely different concepts. This is how the big deception took place. Is it any wonder that now Iran is refusing any "memorandums" or "agreements" with the West, if these are just worthless pieces of paper.

We are now gaining popularity other "attractions". The authorities advise citizens to select in advance reliable shelters in case of Russian ground and aerial bombardments. It is advised to hide in underpasses, subways and old bomb shelters from the Cold War. It is only in these shelters that ventilation has long been plundered for scrap metal, many have been turned into warehouses. So only He Who Above Us can protect us from Russian bombs, but not the Budapest memorandum."
